BAPTISMS: Parents must call the parish office to set up a meeting with the Administrator before registering for the baptism of a child. ADULT RELIGIOUS EDUCATION; S1: Sep to Dec/S2 Jan to Apr Thursday: 7pm—9pm in parish hall when enrollment permits.

FIRST EUCHARIST, FIRST PENANCE AND CONFIRMATION:

The diocesan requirements for these sacraments mandate a consecutive two-year program in religious education. Parents are also required to participate in a two-year program.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: It is the parents who have the first and primary responsibility for educating their children in faith.
