## GUIDELINES RULES POLICIES CALVARY CATHOLIC CEMETERY LAREDO, TEXAS

## TO INSURE OUR CLIENTS THE BEST SERVICE, THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THESE RULES IS ESSENTIAL. ALL VIOLATIONS WILL BE CORRECTED.

- All floral decorations live & artificial must be in containers. Pick up day for all floral arrangements after a funeral is on the 5th day (starting from the burial day). All floral decorations live & artificial, new & old will be removed on the 1st Wednesday, Thursday, & Friday on the months of February, April, August, & October.
- No plants or trees are allowed unless authorized by the cemetery Director. We will not be responsible for any trees or plants. If trees or plants are planted without proper authorization from office, they will be remove without any notification to the family.
- Before marker or monument installation you must wait at least 6 months after burial. You must pick up a Marker Description Allowed Form from office which is taken to monument dealer for correct size and type or material allowed. (Bronze or Natural Granite). Your account must be paid in full and a permit & foundation must be purchased at the cemetery office. A work order will be given for concrete foundation pouring 30 work days after order is given. The following are not allowed, artificial granite, plaster, stone, crushed rock, pine bark, cement, wooden, plastic, glass, paper, crosses, vases, fence, etc., including but not limited to markers other than allowed in area. These will be removed. No trenching allowed. No garden decorations allowed. No alcohol beverage, candies or any edible thing is allowed on grave sites because this will attract ants and other pests.
- Areas where bronze markers only are required and areas where natural granite markers are allowed are determined at the sole discretion of Calvary Catholic Cemetery. No flower vases allowed on individual headmarkers on family plots. The plot owner and heirs will be responsible for the monument and marker upkeep.
- On areas where monuments are allowed, only one monument at the center of a family plot is allowed. The areas where monuments are allowed are determined at the sole discretion of Calvary Catholic Cemetery. Flower vases must be within the granite base. No flower vases allowed on individual headmarkers on family plots. The plot owner and heirs will be responsible for the monument and marker upkeep.
- Only floral decorations which reflect the spiritual nature of Christian death will be permitted. Items of a secular nature are not permitted. All items not allowed will be removed without notification to the family.
- Persons desiring more information may come by the office during regular business hours Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The gates open from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Sunday and during the fall season gates open at 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
