## REGULATIONS REGARDING GRAVESITE DECORATION

- All flowers and decorations are removed on the 1<sup>st</sup> Wednesday, Thursday and Friday of the following months. February, April, August, and October. After burial, flowers are removed from gravesite and mausoleum on or after the 5<sup>th</sup> day.
- 2) No plants or trees allowed unless authorized by cemetery director.
- You must purchase a permit and foundation for each marker or monument installed. Permits and foundations are sold at the Calvary Catholic Cemetery office.
- 4) The monument/marker is not be installed until six months after the burial date.
- No metal, marble, concrete, wooden or artificial granite markers or borders allowed. Exception marble markers allowed to match existing markers or plot.
- 6) No garden or secular decorations are allowed.
- 7) All floral arrangements must be placed at head of the grave only.
- No flower vases allowed on individual grave markers on family plots. The only vases allowed are on base of family monument.
- 9) All decorations, monuments and markers must conform with the moral and religious teachings of the Roman Catholic Church as interpreted by the bishop of this Diocese.
