

REGULATIONS REGARDING GRAVESITE DECORATION

- 1) All flowers and decorations are removed on the 1st Wednesday, Thursday and Friday of the following months. February, April, August, and October. After burial, flowers are removed from gravesite and mausoleum on or after the 5th day.
- 2) No plants or trees allowed unless authorized by cemetery director.
- 3) You must purchase a permit and foundation for each marker or monument installed. Permits and foundations are sold at the Calvary Catholic Cemetery office.
- 4) The monument/marker is not be installed until six months after the burial date.
- 5) No metal, marble, concrete, wooden or artificial granite markers or borders allowed. Exception - marble markers allowed to match existing markers or plot.
- 6) No garden or secular decorations are allowed.
- 7) All floral arrangements must be placed at head of the grave only.
- 8) No flower vases allowed on individual grave markers on family plots. The only vases allowed are on base of family monument.
- 9) All decorations, monuments and markers must conform with the moral and religious teachings of the Roman Catholic Church as interpreted by the bishop of this Diocese.
